

Hesser Memorial Scholarship Application

Those who knew Myrtle Hesser, a food service worker and supervisor in the UO dorms from 1957-72, discovered a warm and friendly person with a wry sense of humor and a soft spot for the students she fed. While Ms. Hesser had little formal education herself, she was smart and well read and chose to leave her entire estate to the University of Oregon for student scholarships.

Eligibility: Eligible students must have a physical disability, such that it significantly impacts the student's ability to work and attend school, or that the student incurs significant expenses that are related to the disability. Students must be admitted to or enrolled full time in an undergraduate or graduate program at the University of Oregon. If the student cannot attend full-time due to the disability, the scholarship may be prorated for the term or year. Preference will be given to freshmen and sophomores with a minimum 3.2 high school GPA or 3.0 college GPA. Selection will be based on financial need, academic ability and impact of disability. The scholarship award amount for 2021-2022 is not yet determined and may begin as soon as Spring 2021. This scholarship is renewable for up to 5 years based on continued eligibility.
